

Summer checklist for the use of the Hohganthütte SAC

- The hut is not manned, you leave the hut as you wish to find it.
- You cook with wood, please use it sparingly. We carry and/or fly the wood to the hut (at a cost). The ash bucket and compostable waste at you can dispose the compost site (marked with a sign and pole to the west of the hut).

 A complete infrastructure is available for eating and cooking. You bring everything you eat or cook with you. In the hut you have free access to: Salt, sugar, tea (various flavors), coffee, fuel for fondue rechauds (4 rechauds with caquelon). Please take the food **NOT** consumed back home.
- Dishwashing detergent and kitchen linen are available in the hut. You may leave the dirty laundry dried in the rack and replace it with clean laundry.
- Drinks are available in the hut. Red wine: Dôle and Murviedro. White wine: Fendant and Chasselas in the floor hatch in the lounge. Beer ½ liter cans. Mineral ½ liter Pet: Nature, Rivella, Citro, apple spritzer. You pay for what you consume (wine 7 dl CHF 30.-, beer CHF 6.- and mineral CHF 5.-).
- It goes without saying that you should take your garbage (including empty bottles and cans) home with you. Multipurpose bags are available.
- There is water at the fountain in front of the hut. Open the tap at the back of the Brunnstock with the appropriate key, let the water run into the chrome steel kettle and close the tap again. Water is rare in the Hohgant region, so take care of it!
- The hut is located in a nature reserve. The construction of open fires for barbecuing or similar is not permitted in accordance with the protection regulations (Government Council Decree No. 3598).
- The hut is equipped with solar light. The light goes out after two hours. You press the switch again and the light illuminates the room for another two hours. The switches are located in easily accessible places by the doors and in the kitchen. Do not light candles (fire hazard).
- The dry toilet and a urinal are located right next to the hut. Urinating in the area around the hut is prohibited.
- Medication for first aid and medical emergencies is available in the hut.
- For the stay in the hut, hut finches (also children's sizes) are available.
- The sleeping places are equipped with mattresses, pillows and woolen blankets (2-3 pieces per sleeping place). The use of a personal sheet or silk sleeping bag is **mandatory.**
- Dogs may not be brought into the hut and must remain outside, even overnight. Leaving dogs unattended in the area of the hut is prohibited.
- The entry in the hut book **is mandatory**. You enter your settlement in the hut book for overnight stays and consumptions and pay in cash (please use an envelope) directly into the cash box, you can also "Twint", or settle your bill via our PC account at Valiant Bank AG, 3550 Langnau
 - PC account: 30-5740-9; IBAN: CH31 0630 0016 0062 9820 0 Sektion Emmental SAC, 3550 Langnau im Emmental (EZ in the hut).
- Close all windows and shutters when leaving the hut. Secure the bottom half of the door with the sliding bolt. You can pull the upper door closed with a little momentum, but please operate the inner door latch first. Check that the lock has locked (hammer on the door with your fist).
- There is a paid parking lot in Schwarzbach (Möser). You can buy a ticket at the ticket machine on the Lombachalp. Driving to Alp Älgäuli is prohibited. In exceptional cases, access is allowed for the transportation of materials and disabled persons. The vehicle must then be parked in the Schwarzbach (the Alp Corporation accepts no liability for damage to vehicles caused by grazing cows).
